



MASTER OF NURSING PROGRAM NURSE PRACTITIONER STREAM

Aurora College, in partnership with Dalhousie University, is pleased to announce our Master of Nursing Program, Nurse Practitioner stream. Graduates from this two year program will exit with a Master of Nursing degree and a Primary Health Care Nurse Practitioner (Family, all ages) certificate from Dalhousie University.

The majority of courses will be delivered on-site at Aurora College in Yellowknife. The remainder will be available through distance education with Dalhousie University.

Entrance Requirements – Baccalaureate prepared registered nurse with a minimum of 2 years experience. Applicants must satisfy the general requirements for admission to the Faculty of Graduate Studies at Dalhousie including a minimum "B" standing (3.0 grade point average).
