Workshop Objectives

- To increase the knowledge of perinatal providers in the NWT about **problematic substance use in pregnancy (PSUP)**, including alcohol, tobacco, cocaine, marijuana and prescription opiates.

After this workshop participants will be able to demonstrate increased knowledge and skills around problematic substance use in pregnancy (PSUP), including:

- Screening and identification of women with PSUP;
- Management and/or referral of women with PSUP;
- Screening and assessment of Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD);
- Participants are encouraged to share the knowledge they have gained at the workshop: present information at rounds, host a lunch-and learn, discuss at staff meetings.
- A PRIMA resource manual is provided to all participants.
